LifeLockracing.com dragster posts Friday best of 4.017 seconds

BRAINERD, Minn., Aug. 14, 2009 -- Clay Millican left Brainerd International Raceway Friday night with the No. 9 Top Fuel qualifying position following the first two sessions for Sunday's Lucas Oil Nationals.

The heat was on in Brainerd when Millican made his first attempt -- a tire-hazing 5.727 seconds at 111.35 mph -- and the LifeLockracing.com dragster was 10th in a slow opening round overall. But the team rallied in the cooler second session, enabling the driver from Drummonds, Tenn., to ride down the 1,000-foot track in 4.017 seconds at 301.13 mph.

"Lance (Larsen, team crew chief) adjusted for the track conditions in the second session and the car didn't spin the tires," said Millican. "We're looking forward to Saturday. We get two more chances and we'll make the best of them. We still want to get in the top half of the field for Sunday's race."
